SUBJECT: Execution of Narcotics Search Warrant on Suspected Drug House

On Tuesday at approximately 11:00pm eight officers of the Wilmer Police Department executed a narcotics search warrant at a residence in the 300 block of Cedar Street after a continuing investigation revealed possible drug activity at that location. Nine adults and three small children were found to be in the home when the officers gained entry. A search of the residence revealed an undisclosed amount of what officers believe to be crack cocaine and marijuana. In all six of the suspects were arrested on various charges. Officers contacted CPS due to the situation and concern for the welfare and safety of the children. CPS responded and took custody of all three of the children. While at the location officers answered the cell phone of one of the suspects and spoke with a female that is a known drug user. The female was inquiring about coming to the location. When she rode up on a bicycle it was determined she was intoxicated and was placed under arrest for Public Intoxication bringing the total arrest number to seven.
